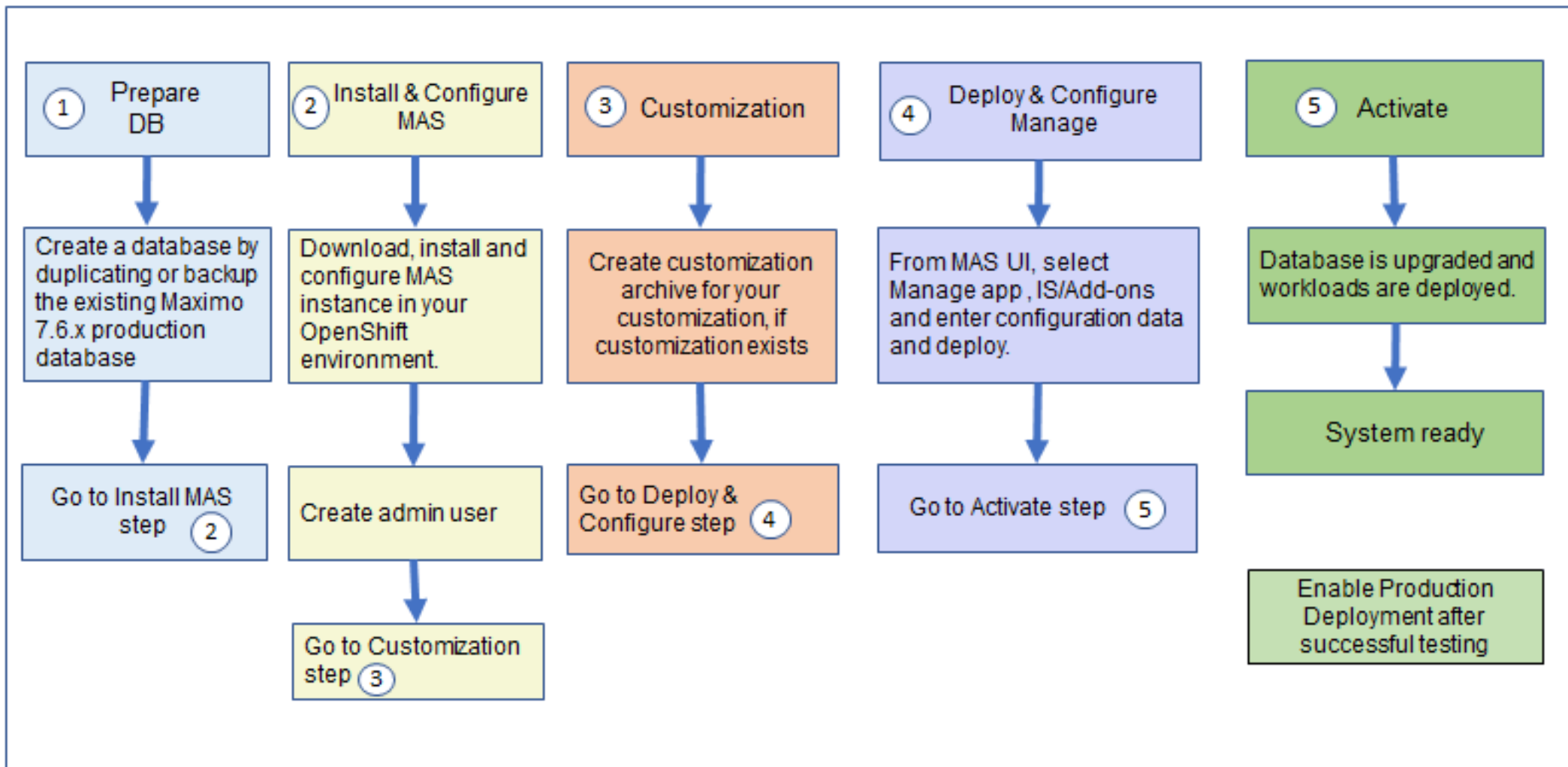

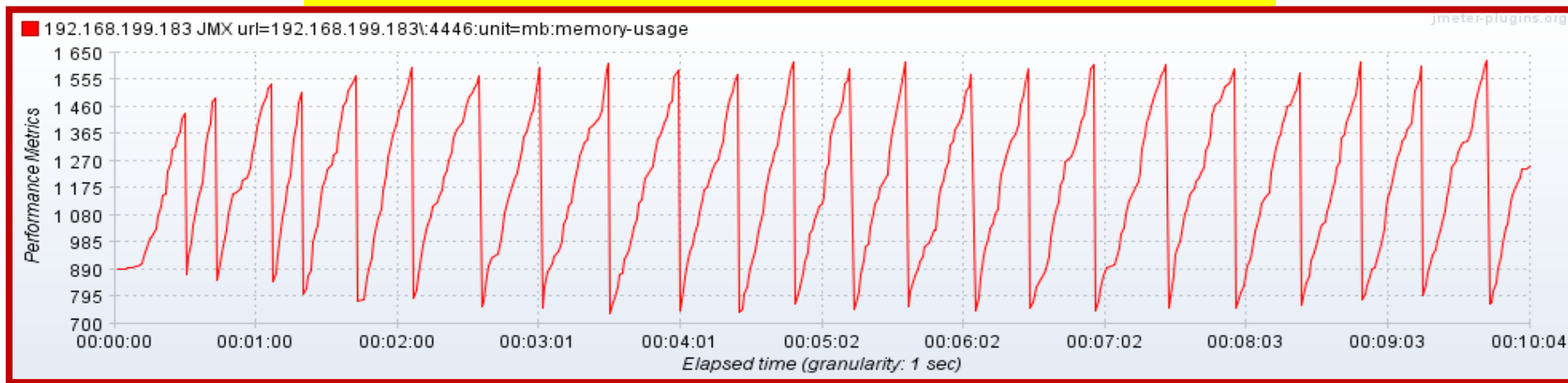

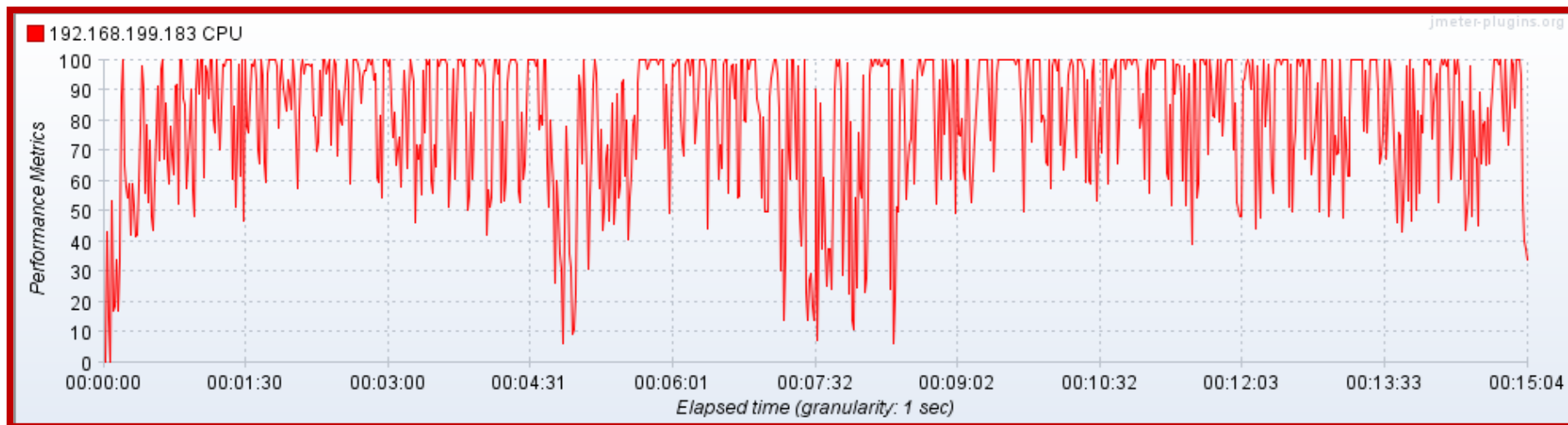
HEAP MEMORY UTILIZATION:
